As part of the formation program for our friars, the Australian Province sends its Post Novices to East Timor to allow them to be immersed in another Capuchin Province and reality.

This year I accompanied Brothers Christopher Maher and Matthew Timonera and from the moment we arrived at each of our two friaries, we were greeted with wonderful brotherly affection which included a traditional weaved Timorese cloth being placed around our necks and the beautiful harmonised voices of the Timorese Postulants, Novices and friars.

Over the 10 days, the communities in Tibar and Laleia generously allowed us to be immersed into the activities and ministries of the friars as well as the program of the students. This is most certainly a rich experience for our Post Novices, not least because it is located in a materially poor yet, in many ways, spiritually rich country. I am sure that Brothers Christopher and Matthew will be able to draw deeply upon this experience as I have done ever since I visited as a Post Novice 10 years ago.





Last March Pope Francis visited Pieltrecina and San Giovanni Rotondo. He met the faithful, the infirm, the clergy and religious and he celebrated Mass in the St. Pio church. It was a day of intense spiritual communion and fervour. He visited the places of of Padre Pio and the Home for the Relief of Suffering **(La Casa Sollievo della Sofferenza).**
