<u>East Timor</u> were in state of emergency until 26th of June; during the lockdown our Friars were working in their house, doing maintenance and repairing. They are now allowed to do some pastoral work and celebrate Masses.

<u>You can support our Missionaries</u>, helping the Capuchins in the spreading of the Gospel and reaching out the poorest in remotes areas of the world. There are different ways to give:

- Seraphic Mass Association: a practical way to offer prayers by sending a Mass Card for the deceased or the living on all occasions (birthdays, anniversaries, healing).
- Seasonal Cards and Novena of Masses: by sending our cards to friends and relatives, you may include them in the series of nine Masses our friars celebrate yearly for Easter, Mother's Day, Father's Day, St. Padre Pio and Christmas.
- Masses for your intentions: due to the restrictions, many of us cannot attend Mass; you may ask our Friars to offer a Mass by sending your particular intentions. A free will offering will be greatly appreciated.

1. Brother Gary Rego OFM Cap made his first profession of the vows of poverty, chastity and obedience during Evening Prayer on Friday, 10th July 2020, the last day of his Novitiate year at San Lorenzo Seminary in Santa Ynez, California USA. The Australian Capuchin province sends its novices to California to complete this important canonical year of their formation together with



other peers in a larger group.

2. Brother Nicholas Singgih completed his Postulancy program in Dutton Park, QLD that ran from August 2019 until July 2020. Postulancy is the first year of formation and dis-





cernment to become a Capuchin friar. He was then sent to the Capuchin Novitiate in Santa Ynez, California and invested in the Capuchin habit (of probation) during Evening Prayer on Sunday, 19th July 2020. He is one of 15 novices from all over the USA and Australia.
